**Jan.** – Stalingrad - The "turning point" on the Eastern Front

**Feb.** – Kasserine Pass- America's first major battle against the Germans

**Mar.** – Kharkov- The third major battle for the city and the last major victory for the Germans in Russia

**Apr.** – Warsaw Ghetto Uprising - A look at the Jewish revolt presented by local author Emily Putzke

**May** – Ruhr Dam Busters Raid - The incredible but true story of Guy Gibson and the epic attack to destroy the Ruhr River Dams.

**Jun.** – Dutch Harbor and the Aleut Evacuation - The story of the fight for the Aleutian Islands

**Jul.** – Battle of Kursk - The largest tank battle in history at that time.

**Aug.** – Ploesti Raid- the story of incredible bravery and sacrifice during operation "Tidal Wave", the air attack on the oil refinery in Romania
